

## **Richard J. Gilbert**

### Biographical Sketch

Richard Gilbert is Emeritus Professor of Economics and Professor of the Graduate School at the University of California at Berkeley. He was Chair of the Department of Economics at Berkeley from 2002 to 2005 and is currently Chair of the Berkeley Competition Policy Center. From 1993 to 1995 he was Deputy Assistant Attorney General in the Antitrust Division of the U.S. Department of Justice. Before serving in the Department of Justice, Professor Gilbert was the director of the University of California Energy Institute and Associate Editor of *The Journal of Industrial Economics*, *The Journal of Economic Theory*, and *The Review of Industrial Organization*. He is a past president of the Industrial Organization Society. Professor Gilbert's research specialties are in the areas of antitrust economics, intellectual property, research and development, and energy markets. Professor Gilbert holds a Ph.D. in Engineering-Economic Systems from Stanford University and Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in Electrical Engineering from Cornell University.
