

Biography Julian Joshua

A partner in the Brussels office of Howrey LLP, Julian Joshua focuses on defending corporation in complex international cartel investigations, advocacy before the European Commission and follow-on litigation. Nominated by GCR as "a leader in the field of cartels work", he specialises in contentious matters and the strategic response to global antitrust investigations by multiple enforcement authorities.

During a 27 year career in the European Commission's Competition Directorate, Mr. Joshua led many successful investigations into Europe-wide price-fixing conspiracies in major industries and is recognised as the architect of the European Commission's investigation and enforcement mechanisms in complex cartel cases. He was also an early exponent of the EC's "pick up the phone" cooperation with the D.O.J.'s Antitrust Division. He currently represents large multinational corporations in both worldwide and European cartel cases, including Air Cargo, Marine Hose, Heat Stabilizers and Freight Forwarders.

The co-author with Professor Chris Harding of a seminal work on cartels, he has also produced many articles and commentaries on cartel law and practice, defence strategy and international criminal enforcement and extradition. He was a member of the International Cartel Task Force of the American Bar Association, and is Honorary Visiting Professor to the City University in London.
