

Paul Malric-Smith is a Head of Unit for Cartels in the European Commission's Directorate General for Competition, based in Brussels. He is responsible for anti-cartel enforcement, as well as a range of policy development initiatives in that field. As acting Director in 2005, he played a key role in setting up and bringing on stream the Directorate dedicated to anti-Cartel activities, which was formally established in June 2005.

Prior to joining the fore-runner of the Cartels Directorate in January 2005, Mr. Malric-Smith occupied positions within DG Competition as Head of Unit in the Merger Task Force, and as Head of the Energy Unit, as well as several assignments in anti-trust enforcement, international relations and policy & coordination.
