Markus H. Meier is the Assistant Director of the Health Care Division of the Federal Trade Commission's Bureau of Competition in Washington, D.C. In this capacity, he has day-to-day management responsibility for an office comprised of more than thirty lawyers, paralegals, and support staff. Markus also leads investigations and litigation involving alleged violations of the antitrust law by physicians and other health-care professionals, pharmaceutical companies, hospitals, and health plans. Markus joined the FTC in 1990.

In January 1998, Markus left the FTC and was with the law firm of Collier, Shannon, Rill & Scott for a year and a half, where he worked on private antitrust litigation and counseling, and represented clients before the FTC and Department of Justice. Markus also has served as a Special Assistant United States Attorney, prosecuting criminal cases in the Eastern District of Virginia, and a resident advisor to the Indonesian Competition Commission in Jakarta.

Prior to joining the FTC, Markus served as an officer in the United States Army. He is a graduate of the George Mason School of Law, has a Masters in Public Administration degree from Old Dominion University, and a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Virginia.
