

## Tim Nord Biography

Tim Nord is a Senior Assistant Attorney General with the Oregon Department of Justice. He currently focuses on antitrust and competition litigation and counseling state agencies on antitrust matters. During his more than a dozen years as an assistant attorney general, he has represented Oregon agencies in a variety of matters, including breach of contract disputes, internal investigations, and statutory enforcement litigation. Prior to joining the Department of Justice, he worked in private practice as a business and commercial litigation attorney. Mr. Nord is an adjunct professor at the University of Oregon Law School teaching antitrust. Mr. Nord obtained his Juris Doctor from the University of Oregon and his undergraduate degree from the University of California at Davis.
