E. Kate Patchen is a Trial Attorney in the San Francisco Field Office of the Antitrust Division, United States Department of Justice. She has investigated and prosecuted international price-fixing cartels. Prior to joining the San Francisco Field Office, Ms. Patchen was a Special Assistant United States Attorney in the Western District of Washington and was assigned to the General Crimes Section. In that capacity, Ms. Patchen prosecuted and tried several criminal cases ranging from narcotics trafficking to bank fraud.
