Joe Simons is co-chair of the Antitrust Group at Paul, Weiss, Rifkind, Wharton & Garrison LLP, resident in the firm's Washington, D.C. office. Prior to joining the firm, he was the chief antitrust enforcer at the Federal Trade Commission, serving as Director of the Bureau of Competition from June 2001 until August 2003.

Along with a former chief economist of the Department of Justice Antitrust Division, Mr. Simons developed "Critical Loss Analysis," a technique for market definition that has been adopted and used by both the Antitrust Division, the FTC, and in the courts.

Mr. Simons has extensive experience representing clients before the FTC, the Department of Justice, the Department of Defense, and the Congress in a wide range of antitrust and regulatory matters, from mergers and acquisitions to price fixing and predation and vertical restraints cases.
