

GROUND TRANSPORTATION TO DOWNTOWN CHICAGO

TAXI

O'Hare International Airport is located approximately 17 miles northwest of downtown Chicago. Taxis are available on a first come, first served basis from the lower level curb front of all terminals. Shared ride service is available. There are no flat rates because all taxis run on meters. Expect to spend approximately \$35 to \$40 for a taxi ride to downtown Chicago from O'Hare International Airport. Midway Airport is located 14 miles southwest of the Marriott. Expect to spend between \$30 and \$35 for a taxi ride to downtown Chicago. For wheelchair accessible vehicles, call United Dispatch at (800) 281-4466.

CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY (CTA)

The CTA Blue Line operates from O'Hare International Airport to downtown Chicago approximately every ten minutes. The CTA fare is currently \$2.25 each way. The train is available via Terminal 2. Transfer from the Blue line to the Red Line (heading towards Howard) at the Monroe stop. The Marriott is 3 blocks from the Grand stop. The Blue Line from O'Hare will take approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.

The CTA Orange Line operates from Midway Airport to downtown Chicago approximately every 15 minutes. The closest Orange Line stop to the Marriott is State and Lake. The State and Lake stop is 6 blocks from the hotel. The Orange Line to the Marriott will take approximately 1 hour and 20 minutes.
