Dear Law School Dean:

The ABA Law Student Division's policy-making body, the Assembly,—comprised of the SBA President and ABA Representative from each ABA-approved law school, or their proxies—convenes each August at the ABA Annual Meeting to review and vote on policy issues affecting law students, legal education and the legal profession. At this meeting, Assembly delegates also elect the Division's three delegates to the ABA House of Delegates, and the SBA Presidents also elect the Division's Vice Chair-SBA.

We respectfully encourage you to support the attendance of your school's SBA President and ABA Representative at the ABA Annual Meeting. In addition to representing your school in the Assembly, the SBA Presidents and ABA Representatives will attend training and leadership workshops to aid them in the coming year and to exchange best practices with other law school leaders. We also hope that you will encourage all interested students from your law school to join fellow law students and lawyers from across the country at the Annual Meeting, so they may experience the depth of the profession firsthand. In addition to representing and participating in Law Student Division activities, students will have the opportunity to participate in more than 2,500 meetings, educational programs and special events, including the Law Student Division Career Fair on August 6 ([www.abanet.org/lsd/career](http://www.abanet.org/lsd/career)).

The Law Student Division's portion of the ABA Annual Meeting takes place August 5-7, 2010 at the San Francisco Marriott Marquis Hotel. Through May 28, the meeting registration fee for law students is \$50 (\$75 for non-members, which includes ABA membership). After May 28, the fee will increase to \$75 for members and \$100 for non-members. This is a substantial discount as compared to the regular member fee of \$470 (\$595 after May 28). In addition, law students are provided with a complimentary "*All Access to CLE badge*" to attend substantive programming at no additional charge.

We encourage you to support the attendance of your SBA President and ABA Representative, as well as other school representatives, at the ABA Annual Meeting. This is an excellent opportunity for law students to become involved in the American Bar Association and the profession as a whole.
