

## JUDSON PAUL HAVERKAMP

Jud Haverkamp is director of publications for the Minnesota State Bar Association and editor of the Association's monthly magazine, *Bench & Bar of Minnesota*. Jud has been working in publications with the voluntary Minnesota Bar for 20 years and has had prior work experience in higher education, in academic book publishing, and as a freelance writer/editor.

Following graduation with a B.A. in Asian History from Earlham College in 1967, Jud served three years with Peace Corps-Thailand. He subsequently worked as an advisor to international students at the University of Massachusetts - Amherst while pursuing graduate work in international and higher education, receiving his M.Ed. in 1976 and achieving Ed.D. candidacy in 1978. From 1975-78 he served as publications coordinator for the University's Center for International Education, editing, designing, and producing six to eight softcover books annually.

After several additional years working in college student personnel services, Jud set himself up as a freelance writer/editor, handling projects in corporate communications, student dissertations, academic manuscripts, and legislative proposals. After editing a centennial book for the Minnesota State Bar in 1984, he joined the staff as editor of *Bench & Bar*.

As director of publications, Jud is responsible for the editorial content, design, production, and fiscal management of *Bench & Bar*, which circulates to 16,000 member-subscribers and produces advertising revenue sufficient to cover direct costs. Jud has designed and conducted multiple reader research surveys, both for editorial development and to support advertising sales, and completed his most recent mail survey in 2003.
