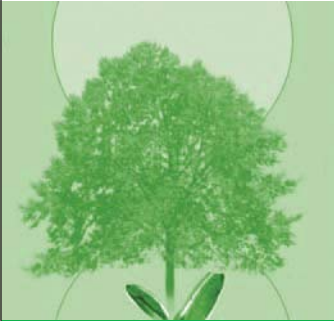
COMINGS AND GOINGS
